The **AMERICAN BOARD OF MEDICAL SPECIALTIES (ABMS)** is a not-for-profit organization that represents 24 medical specialty boards that establish and maintain high standards for doctor certification and the delivery of safe, quality medical care by certified doctor specialists. Certification obtained through one of the ABMS Member Boards denotes that a physician has the appropriate knowledge, skills and experience needed to deliver optimum care in a specific area of medicine. Approximately 85 percent of licensed doctors are certified by ABMS. Doctors of Osteopathy (DOs) can be certified by either the ABMS or the AOA (American Osteopathic Association). More specifically, board certification means the physician graduated from a recognized medical school as either an MD or DO, completed several years of training in an accredited residency program, and passed an extensive written exam given by the board.

Listed here are summaries of 19 board certifying organizations and lists of current members practicing in Northeast Florida.

ALLERGY & IMMUNOLOGY

The **AMERICAN BOARD OF ALLERGY AND IMMUNOLOGY (ABAI)** was established in 1971 as a Conjoint Board of the American Board of Internal Medicine (ABIM) and American Board of Pediatrics (ABP). The ABAI is committed to working closely with its parent boards to maintain the highest educational and clinical standards in the specialty of allergy/immunology.

As of 2009, ABAI transitioned from recertification to a continuous Maintenance of Certification (MOC) program in accordance with American Board of Medicine Specialties (ABMS) MOC® guidelines. Medical specialty certification in the United States is a voluntary process that demonstrates a physician's exceptional exper-

tise in a particular specialty of medical practice.

The ABAI currently has 5,440 Diplomates who are board-certified in Allergy and Immunology. Approximately 25 practice in our area.

AUDIOLOGY

AMERICAN BOARD OF AUDIOLOGY (ABA) certificants have successfully completed a course of graduate study in audiology from a regionally accredited university and have earned a master's or doctoral degree in audiology. In addition, certificants have successfully passed a national examination and have completed a minimum of 2,000 hours of mentored professional practice in a two-year period.

In order to ensure that certificants are up-to-date on the latest technologies and findings in audiology, they are required to engage in continuous learning and to re-certify every three years. Applicants for renewal must demonstrate that they have earned 60 hours of continuing education within that three-year period.

BOARD CERTIFIED PHYSICIANS

From a small gathering in 1984, the AACD has matured into the world's largest organization for cosmetic dental professionals. The group continues to grow and now includes more than 6,000 practitioners, educators, researchers and laboratory technicians from 70 countries. This global perspective allows AACD members to gather information from the international field of cosmetic dentistry.

The AACD's fundamental principle is to promote education, and it is the only organization of its kind to offer a postgraduate certificate by application, presentation and review. Once they begin the process, candidates have five years to complete all the requirements. Following Accreditation, the highest level of distinction offered by the AACD is Fellowship. A select group of accredited members pursue Fellowship each year, which further proves a member's dedication to the art and science of cosmetic dentistry.

Presently there are about 30 AACD members practicing in Northeast Florida.

DERMATOLOGY

A dermatologist is a physician who specializes in skin care. This doctor receives extensive training in treating skin problems and helping to keep skin healthy. When a dermatologist is board certified, it means that the dermatologist has completed a three-year residency in dermatology and passed a two-part test administered by the American Board of Dermatology. Most, but not all, members of the **AMERICAN ACADEMY OF DERMATOLOGY (AAD)** are board certified in dermatology. Fellow membership in AAD is offered to those individuals certified in dermatology by the American Board of Dermatology or the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada.

Some dermatologists gain additional training and expertise in specific areas of dermatology, such as pediatrics, surgery or cosmetics, and may go on to have practices specializing in these areas.

According to the AAD, there are approximately 50 member dermatologists working in our region.
