We understand that visiting any healthcare facility during this time can be unsettling, and we want to share with you some of the specific measures we have in place.

WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT FROM US:

Screening - We continue to screen all patients and visitors with our COVID-19 screening questionnaire. Stay home if you are unwell. If you are experiencing fever, cough, or shortness of breath you should be seen by your physician for COVID-19 testing.

Staff Screening - Anyone exhibiting symptoms, or has been in close contact with an individual with COVID-19, is quarantined according to the current Center for Disease Control Guidelines prior to returning to work. Our staff will work only if they are healthy and only if they wear the proper personal protective equipment.

Wear a Mask - All patients should bring a mask or facial covering to wear when they come to our office. All staff members are required to wear a mask at all times.

Extensive Cleaning - While cleaning our treatment areas and waiting room has always been a priority, enhanced cleaning protocols are in place to help ensure your safety. We are following all recommendations from the CDC.

Enforcement of Social Distancing - Our waiting areas are arranged to provide appropriate separation between seats. Hand sanitation stations are also dispersed throughout the office.
