

A grand total of 36 people joined our team as we traveled to Camalote, Belize to help others with dental care, medical care, and construction work. The dental team included 2 general dentists, 4 hygienists, and 4 support people providing over 275 screenings and cleanings in addition to treating 180 patients. The medical team: 4 doctors, 4 nurses, and 3 support peopletreated over 500 patients and performed 2 surgeries. The construction group tiled and plumbed an

entire bath house in addition to replacing a metal roof. We met numerous physical needs and shared the love of Christ with these people as we served them.
