

Insurance

If your employer provides insurance for you, it can be a great help in affording the necessary treatment.

Please remember that dental insurance is a contract between you, your employer and the insurance company. No insurance policy covers all procedures, none pay Hawaii State Tax; some have deductibles and waiting periods.

The extent of your insurance reimbursement is NOT within our control; so, please remember that you are ultimately responsible for your entire account.

Any past due amounts will be assessed a 1.5% monthly late payment penalty.

If you provide us with the correct information (company, group number, etc.) we will be happy to assist you by filing a claim to obtain the maximum insurance benefits to which you are entitled.

We will do our best to estimate the amount the insurance company will pay. You will only need to pay the estimated "patient share" on the day you receive treatment.

By maintaining your signature on file (see below), the participating insurance company will pay your benefits to our office and then we can immediately credit your Visa or MasterCard account if the payment exceeds our estimate, or charge your account the exact difference the day the insurance check is received.
