We want to tell you that the level of care will not change, however, there will be several changes to your visit to ensure your safety. Our expectation is to re-open on May 18. Our team will reach out to you to plan your next visit.

Our office follows state and American Dental Association(ADA) recommendations and guidelines, so that we are up to date on any new guidance.

You will see changes when you come in for your next appointment. These changes are to protect our patients and staff. For example:

1. Our office will communicate with you prior to your appointment to ask screening questions. You will be asked those questions again when you are at the office.
2. You will be asked to arrive with a mask and to use hand sanitizer upon entering.
3. There will be no waiting room seating available. You will wait in your car, and once we are ready for your appointment, we call your cell phone.
4. Curbside check-in.
5. Touch-less temperature screening.
6. Plexiglass barriers
7. Appointments will be managed to allow social distancing, please be patient as there will be less options for scheduling and longer time allotted to each appointment.
