3 years to 5 years

You child should be seen annually for a well child visit to receive a routine physical exam, assessment of growth and development, and anticipatory guidance. At these visits we monitor your child's physical and emotional development as well as preparation for kindergarten. Vaccines given prior to kindergarten include DTaP, Polio, MMR, Varicella and Influenza. Screening will include vision, hearing, blood pressure and hemoglobin. School and daycare forms will be completed at each of your child's well visits.

- Full physical examination
- Assessment of growth and development
- Anticipatory guidance on topics including diet, development, safety and school readiness
- Vision screen yearly
- Hearing screen and hemoglobin at 5 years old visit
- Immunizations given at 4 years of age—DTaP and Polio combined vaccine and MMR and Varicella combined vaccine (Influenza vaccine if indicated)
- Tuberculosis risk assessment for daycare or school entry.
