Eczema Treatment Plan

For acute flare of eczema:

•	Bleach baths: ½ cup of regular houshold bleach in full bathtub of luke-warm water for no longer than 10 minutes. Please perform bleach baths for consecutive days during acute flare, followed by twice a week thereafter. Wet wraps: After nightly bath apply to entire body, followed by layer of Aquaphor/Vaseline. Dampen some pajamas (onesies are great for babies and toddlers, otherwise, use a long sleeve shirt and long pants) and have your child wear the damp pajamas to bed. Your child should sleep in a warm room with humidified air. Please perform wet wraps for consecutive days. (Optional: another dry layer of pajamas may be used on top of damp pajamas if this is more comfortable for your child).
•	For itch: Hydroxyzine at night and every 6 hours as needed during the day time.
•	Apply to entire body twice a day.
•	Apply Aquaphor/ Vaseline to entire body every time you change a diaper.
•	Apply Elidel/ Protopic/ Hydrocortisone 2.5% ointment to face twice a day.
•	For your infection, please take BActrim/ Keflex times a day for days.
For Maintenance treatment of eczema:	
•	Perform bleach baths twice a weeks
•	Apply to entire body twice a day for 2 days per
	week.
•	Apply Elidel/ Protopic/ hydrocortisone 2.5% ointment to face twice a day for 2
•	days per week.
•	Apply Aquaphor/ Vaseline to entire body every time you change a diaper, or at
	twice a day.
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
