You can resume your normal dosing after the procedure once you have eaten. Plan on being at the facility for 2-3 hours. Someone must drive you home. No public transportation allowed without a chaperone. You will be sedated for your procedure and will be very drowsy for several hours. You may not drive or work for 12 hours after the procedure.
