	<ul> <li>You will need to follow a clear liquid diet for dinner. Approved clear liquids include: water, clear juices without pulp (such as apple juice), soda, chicken or beef broth, popsicles and Jell-o (yellow and orange ONLY), tea, coffee, and lemonade. Do not drink anything red, green, or purple. No solid food and no dairy products such as milk or creamers.</li> <li>Diabetic patients should only take a half dose of diabetic medications.</li> <li>Drink 1 bottle of magnesium citrate after dinner.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Day of Procedure:</li> <li>Do not eat or drink anything after midnight.</li> <li>Take 1st enema in the morning when you wake up. Try to hold the liquid in for 15 minutes. If this is not possible, at least 5 minutes is acceptable.</li> <li>Take 2nd enema 30 minutes to 1 hour before heading to the facility. Try to hold the liquid in for 15 minutes. If this is not possible, at least 5 minutes is acceptable.</li> <li>If possible, hold all medication unless otherwise directed. High blood pressure medication may be taken with a SIP OF WATER.</li> <li>Diabetic patients should not take diabetic medication the morning of the procedure. You can resume your normal dosing after the procedure once you have eaten.</li> <li>Plan on being at the facility for 2-3 hours.</li> <li>Someone must drive you home. No public transportation allowed without a chaperone. You will be sedated for your procedure and will be very drowsy for several hours. You may not drive or work for 12 hours after the procedure.</li> </ul>
