- Wound care treatment plans including wound management both surgical and non-surgical, debridement of wound, grafting, and medicated treatment options including but not limited to stem cell and platelet rich therapy.
- Utilizes regenerative medicine for treatment not only of wounds, but also multiple foot and ankle injuries and tendon ruptures allowing many patients to avoid surgical intervention.
- Diagnose diseases and deformities of the foot using medical histories, physical examinations, x-rays, and laboratory test results.
- Prescribe medications, corrective devices, physical therapy, or surgery.
- Advise patients about treatments and foot care techniques necessary for prevention of future problems.
- Treat bone, muscle, and joint disorders affecting the feet and ankles.
- Refer patients to physicians when symptoms indicative of systemic disorders, such as arthritis or diabetes, are observed in feet and legs.
- Make and fit prosthetic appliances.
- Correct deformities by means of plaster casts and strapping.
- Educate the public about the benefits of foot care through techniques such as speaking engagements, advertising, and other forums.
- Detect, diagnose, and treat fungal infections including onychomycosis, verruca plantaris, and tinea pedis which includes but is not limited to medications, laser treatments, and cantharadine regimen.
