

# Acetaminophen Dosing Chart

Dose – Give the dose indicated below every 4 hours; do not give more than 5 doses in 24 hours. Use only as directed.

Remember:

- Do not use with any other product containing acetaminophen
- Check with your healthcare provider if you have any questions
- Check with your healthcare provider when giving medication to infants under 2 months of age.
- Always read and follow the label directions
- Whenever possible, use weight to determine dosage.
- For accurate dosing, only use the dosing device that comes with the product
- Do not give adult medicines to infants/children
- Keep all medicines out of the reach of children
