Food for Thought: Turmeric

Turmeric is a bright yellow spice from a plant in the ginger family, which is native to the Indian subcontinent. It is a commonly used spice in Indian cooking and in many curries. It is also classically mixed into a paste and applied to the faces of brides and grooms on the day before their wedding, to impart a healthy glow to the skin. Turmeric contains a molecule called curcumin that is known to have very potent anti-inflammatory properties. In addition to its use in cooking, turmeric is frequently used in Ayurveda (an ancient traditional form of Indian medicine) for its medicinal properties. As research into turmeric and our knowledge of its health benefits grows, its uses in Western medicine are expanding. Turmeric has been studied not only for the skin, but also for its effect on a myriad of other health conditions including arthritis, heart disease, Alzheimer's disease, and cancer.

Many skin conditions are mediated by inflammation, including psoriasis, eczema, and lichen planus. Some studies have shown improvement in these inflammatory conditions with oral curcumin supplementation, an anti-inflammatory agent. Oral curcuminoid supplements are available over-the-counter, but please check with your primary care physician before starting any supplements.

Turmeric is difficult to incorporate into topical formulations such as creams and lotions, due to its bright yellow and the risk of staining the skin. DDF (Doctor's Dermatologic Formula) has a skincare line containing purified **turmeric** complex that is not yellow- these products can be found online and in some stores. But an easier, less expensive and more delicious way to reap the benefits of **turmeric** is through your diet. There are many easy to follow curry and Indian recipes that incorporate turmeric; add this spice as a staple to your pantry and you will be doing your skin and palate a huge favor!

Chicken skin: do you have keratosis pilaris?

Keratosis pilaris (KP) refers to the development of small rough bumps and redness around hair follicles, most commonly on the upper arms and thighs (although it can occur on the face, back and buttocks as well). It is a very common skin

condition, affecting about 50% of the world's population. The bumps of **KP** are caused by the buildup of skin cells and keratin (a protein) around individual hair follicles. Oftentimes, the buildup around the hair follicle traps the hair underneath, and can lead to folliculitis (acne-like bumps) as well. Redness around these bumps is due to inflammation of the hair follicles. **KP** may sometimes be itchy, or may not cause any symptoms at all.

The cause of **KP** is unknown, but it may be associated with other dry skin conditions such as eczema and ichthyosis vulgaris. About 30-50% of cases of **KP** are hereditary. Seasonal variation is common, with the condition being worse in the winter (when skin tends to be drier) and better in the summer. Although this is a harmless condition, it can be visually displeasing to patients and cause significant self-consciousness and embarrassment if not treated. While **KP** is a chronic condition without a known cure, there are treatment options that can help control the symptoms and smooth out the surface of the skin. These include:

Exfoliating creams and washes to help speed skin cell turnover and loosen buildup around hair follicles.

The D&A Dermatology KP Kit is an excellent treatment regimen for **KP**. The kit contains an exfoliating bodywash, exfoliating lotion and exfoliating spray with details instructions for AM & PM use

For those patients desiring a simpler regimen, **Akerat cream** is an effective exfoliating lotion that contains urea, lactic acid and glycolic acid. It can be applied to the affected areas once or twice a day.

A short course of a topical steroid cream or immunomodulator cream may be prescribed to treat significant redness caused by inflammation.

In-office treatments such as chemical peels and microdermabrasions provide excellent exfoliation of the skin. These are idea choices for the treatment of **KP** before a big event such as a wedding or vacation.
