How will my Surgery Be Scheduled?

Once the Location and Date have been chosen what else will you need to do?

- **Pre-Operative Appointment** with your surgeon / Dr. Jonathan Richards at any office location This appointment **is mandatory**. You will need to go over the procedure with the Dr., sign consent forms, receive prescriptions, post operative care instructions and pre operative x-rays. If you need a Post Op boot or shoe this will be dispensed to you at this appointment to bring to the surgery. This is your opportunity to ask any questions before the procedure.
- Disability Forms please drop off any forms needed at the pre-operative appointment or email them to footdrx2@gmail.com / You are not disabled till after the surgery is completed. Forms will be completed then. (\$20.00 Fee for surgical disability forms)
- Medical Clearance for Surgery the Surgical Coordinator will email you the Prescription for your PCP-Primary Care Physician to complete. Must be done within 30 days of the surgery and received a week before the procedure. Please read this form and if you have any questions please contact the Surgical Coordinator ASAP. Failure to complete the clearance will postpone / cancel your procedure by the surgical facility.
