WHAT TO EXPECT AFTER YOUR THYROIDECTOMY/PARATHYROIDECTOMY

- 1. Call Dr. Tan if you experience:
 - a. Difficulty breathing or the sensation of your throat swelling or closing up.
 - i. This may indicate bleeding underneath the incision site.
 - b. Muscle cramps and/or tingling or numbness, especially around your mouth, face or fingers.
 - i. This may indicate low blood calcium which needs to be treated. Begin taking Tums 2 tablets three times a day and call our office.
- 2. Keep surgical tape on neck until seen for follow up visit. Ok to shower with the tape on.
- 3. No heavy lifting, strenuous exercise, or excessive neck stretching for two weeks.
- 4. No Coumadin, Plavix, Aspirin, Motrin, or other blood thinning medications for 7 days after surgery.
- 5. Schedule follow-up appointment to see Dr. Tan 6-10 days after surgery.
- 6. Make appointment with your endocrinologist/primary care physician.
