Posters will be accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis as long as space permits.

When creating your abstract, please note the following guidelines:

1. Eligibility: Original abstracts that either have or have not been presented at other meetings will be permitted
2. Format:
  - a. Title: Brief and state content of paper
  - b. Authors: List name and degree for each
  - c. Abstract
    - i. Purpose for study
    - ii. Statement of methods
    - iii. Summary of Results
    - iv. Conclusion
