Deductibles/Co-Insurance Info

Many insurance plans apply deductibles/co-insurance to testing or procedures performed during your visit. Separate codes are used for add-on items and are not included with the exam, even if performed at a scheduled well-exam.

Let your care provider know if you do not want a test or procedure performed or if you would like to call your insurance plan carrier BEFORE it has been performed.

Here is a list of the more common tests/procedures that may result in additional fees billed by our office after insurance has processed:

Common In-House Lab tests:

- Strep
- Mono
- Cholesterol and Lipid tests
- CBC
- Hemoglobin (no-stick finger probe)
- Urinalysis or Pregnancy tests
- Flu A and Flu B (billed as 2 tests)

Common Procedures:

- Dental Fluoride Varnish (out of pocket \$15 max)
- Wart Removal

The Use of Outside Services:

If you have blood drawn at our office to be sent to an OUTSIDE LAB, you may receive a separate bill from the outside lab. We use Rex Lab and LabCorp.

You are responsible for confirming with your insurance plan if you have plan restrictions for facilities such as: Labs, radiology offices, hospitals, etc.

Test and Procedure Locations can often be changed at your request.
