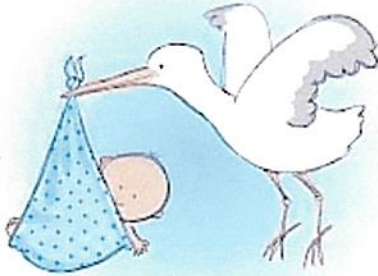


Circumcision



Congratulations on expecting a baby boy! The decision to circumcise your son is typically personal or religious. Our expert pediatricians are able to perform this procedure in office. Physicians at Littleton Pediatric Medical Center will help parents understand the pros and cons of the procedure, so you can choose what's best for your child.

What is a circumcision?

Male infants are born with a covering, foreskin, over the head of their penis. The foreskin is attached to the penis, and, over time, it separates from the head and can be pulled back for cleaning of the penis head. A circumcision removes the foreskin. The procedure is usually performed by a Littleton Pediatric Medical Center physician within the first few days after birth, and can be done up to one month of age in-office. The procedure is conducted with a local anesthetic and is completed using the plastibell method.
