TTEC

A major highlight has been the Trans-Tasman Endodontic Conference held in Sydney in early June over 4 days (postponed from the previous year)

The principal overseas speakers were Dr Bruno Azevado (from the USA) who discussed advances in CBCT imaging and Dr David Clark (USA) who discussed the issues associated with the biomechanics of restoring endodontically-treated teeth, and provided innovative solutions to the problems.

These speakers were also supported by a range of international and local speakers, covering a wide range of topics. There were also "hands on" clinics to demonstrate Dr Clark's restorative techniques.

The social program was excellent, and included an evening trip by ship on beautiful Sydney Harbour, with dinner on board.

NZSE introduced its first webinar series that addresses 10 key topics in Endodontics. This series intends to refresh and extend clinicians knowledge to assist them in their day-to-day practice. It will explore the best available evidence-based literature and provide practical tips for better care of all patient groups. It also aims to provide convenient affordable education to help clinicians in their professional development plan.

The topics ranged from understanding pulp and periapical disease, diagnosis and treatment planning, management strategies and providing simple to complex treatment using hand files and rotary instrumentation. NZSE brought together an outstanding line-up of specialist endodontists from both private practice and academic settings.

Registration was available for individual sessions or for the whole series. Access to recordings of the webinar were available for 1 week after each session. The Symposium Chair and facilitator was Dr Dikesh Parmar (BDS, DClinDent (Endo)) and Attendees were encouraged to send through questions for the speakers of each webinar.
