HEMORRHOID BANDING PREPARATION

Banding is a minimally invasive technique that ties the base of a hemorrhoid with a rubber band to stop the blood flow to the hemorrhoid.

THE DAY OF YOUR BANDING APPOINTMENT

Be sure to administer a fleet enema 2 hours prior to your appointment time.
Fleet enemas can be found over the counter at most drug stores.

AFTER YOUR BANDING APPOINTMENT

Call your provider if you experience any of the following symptoms:

- Bleeding lasting longer than 3 days
- Fever/chills
- Excessive bleeding during bowel movements
