- Provides evidence-based care. Providers use current best evidence in making decisions about patient care. ESD's providers integrate both individual clinical expertise with the best available external evidence, and neither alone is enough.
- Helps you understand your child's conditions and how to take care of your child. We explain your options and help you make decisions about your child's care. - Helps you coordinate your health care -- even if we are not the ones giving you the care. ESD's care coordinator will help you find specialists, get appointments, and make sure specialists have the information they need to care for your child. If the patient is experiencing barriers to care, the ESD team will work to provide resources to help minimize these obstacles.
